Vancouver Electric Vehicle Association (VEVA) assumes no responsibility or liability for your participation at this free event. All participants, exhibitors, are responsible for their own vehicles, displays, tables, tents, and signs.

As a celebration of electric transportation, all vehicles at this event must have an electrical plug for motive power. receives electricity for motive power. Late registrations must be completed by **9:00am on the day of the event**.

All exhibitors are responsible for leaving their designated space at the event free from any debris or garbage at the conclusion of the event.

Vehicle Demonstrations: If you wish to demonstrate your vehicle the following rules must be strictly adhered to:

- Drivers of any demonstrated vehicle must either be **the owner**, or a **driver with direct knowledge and previous experience with the vehicle designated by the owner**, in order to operate the vehicle for demonstration.
- All vehicles must be driven in a responsible manner to ensure the safety of the participant and the general public attending this event.
- All vehicle demonstrations are limited to the fenced in lot to the west of the site. Note that electric bicycles (defined by legislation as 500 watts of rated power or less) may be driven by the public on the bike paths adjacent to the event site.
- All motor vehicles demonstrated must meet all regulatory, safety and insurance requirements applicable to the vehicle under BC laws, if applicable. For all road-going EVs which will be driven onsite, please bring a copy/proof of your valid insurance for us to verify. For all two wheel vehicles, tricycles, go karts, skateboards ("open vehicles") demonstrated, **a safety helmet must be worn**. Full protective clothing, including gloves, elbow and knee pads and heavy duty footwear are recommended for such open vehicles.
- VEVA will provide space to registered participants at the event on a first come, first served basis only. **Please plan to arrive early to set up your exhibit or vehicle. You will be checked in and given a registration information card for your exhibit during set up. We would like all set up completed by 9:30 am. Please do not be late as this disrupts the event.** VEVA provides limited charging access for all electric vehicles but cannot guarantee access to the charging or warrant the quality of the charge provided.

Commercial exhibitors are allowed to display their products as they would at a trade show. However, commercial transactions are strictly prohibited onsite, in accord with the agreement with our main sponsor, Concord Pacific.
